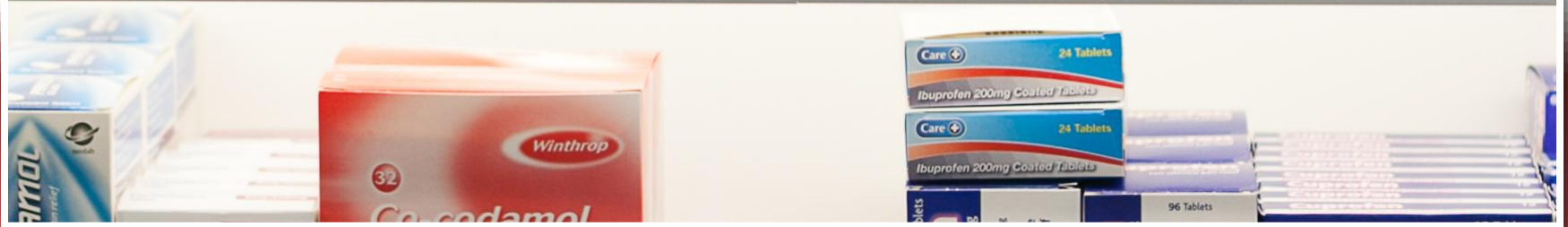




ANDREW ROSINDELL, MP, ROMFORD LAUNCHES NEW MEDICINES SERVICE
