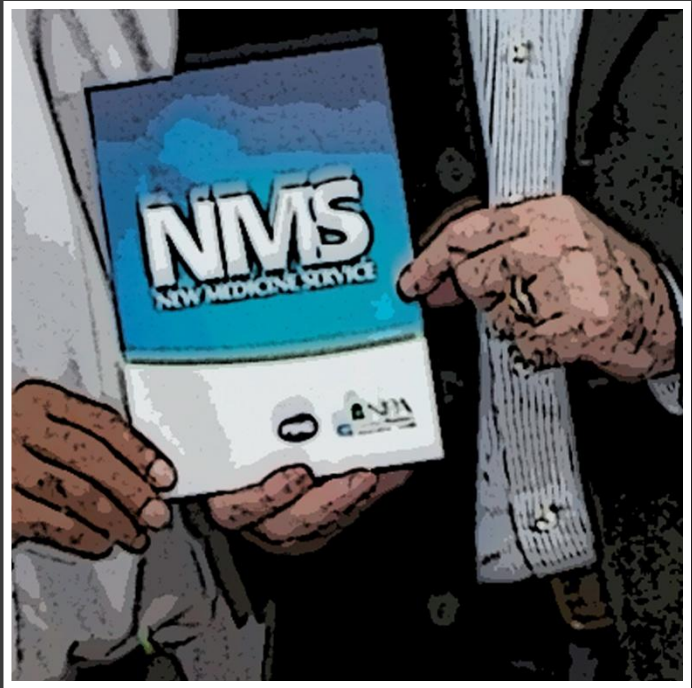




# NIRMAL SINGH SEHMI HOSTS MP VISIT

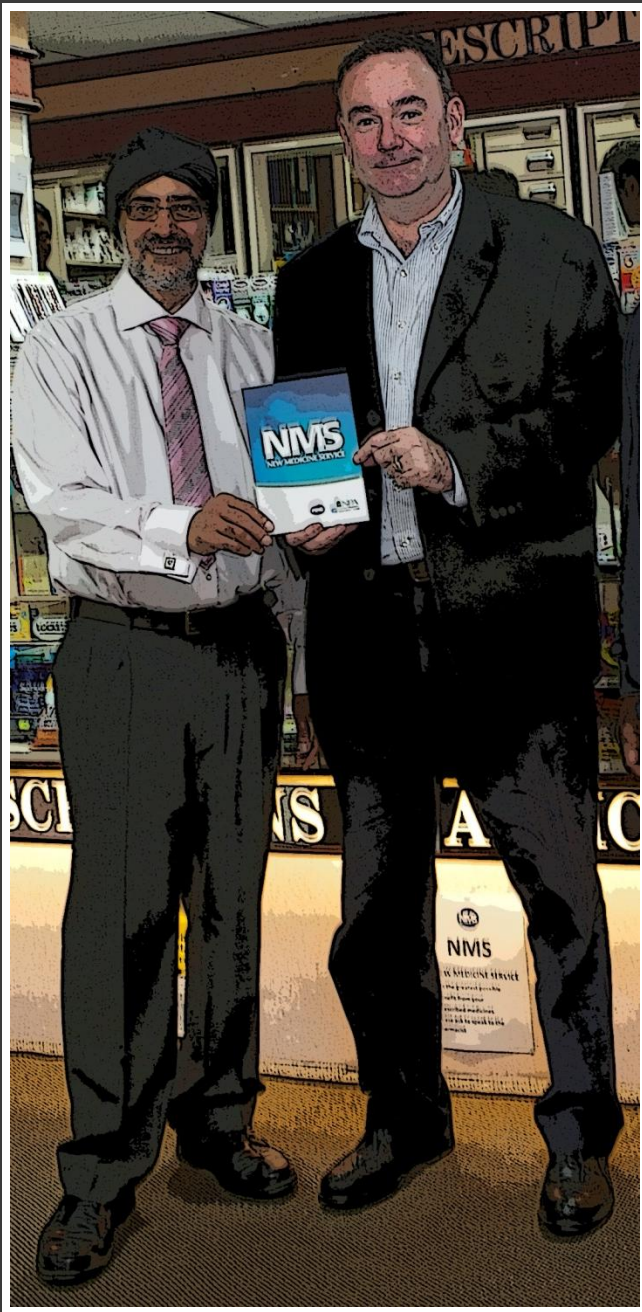

Jon Cruddas poses with Oxlow Chemist staff who are all looking forward to making a contribution to help Nirmal reach his target each month.

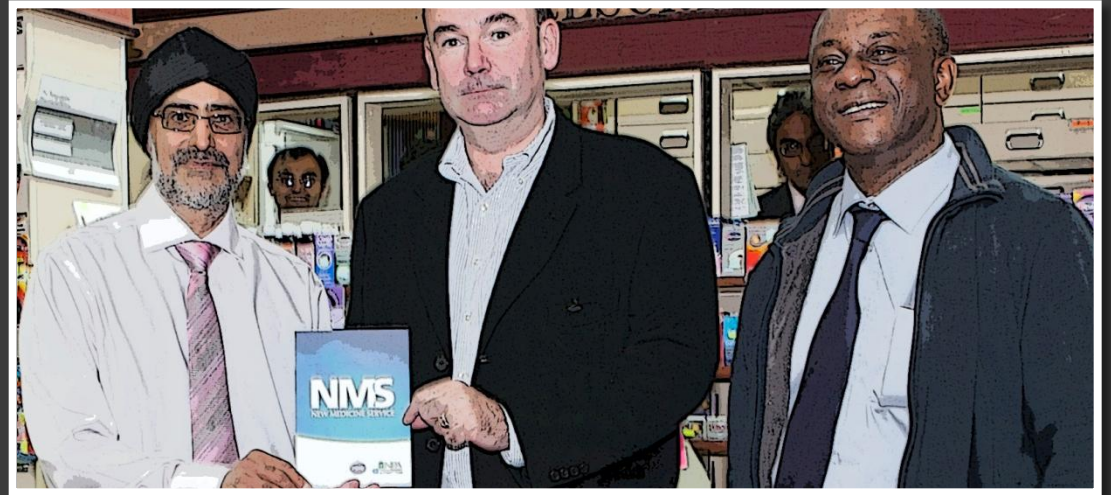
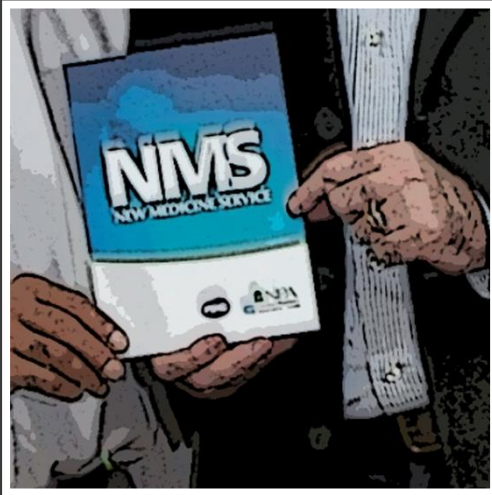
